Alejandra Molina is an Emmy® Award winning journalist who currently anchors the station's newscast, "Noticiero Telemundo 51", weekdays at 6:00PM and 11:00PM, from the station's Miramar based studios.

Molina joined Telemundo 51 / WSCV, the local Miami television station that serves the Spanish speaking community, in July of 2015. As part of the Telemundo 51 award winning news team, she not only delivers the day's local news, but also breaking news and major stories impacting the South Florida community. Molina also anchored the Noon, 5:00PM and 5:30PM newscasts for many years.

Prior to working at Telemundo 51, Molina spent more than a decade working at WJAN America TV in Miami. She began her career there in 2005, as an evening news anchor for "Noticias 41" at 10:00 PM. In 2012, she also became a co-anchor of "AN6", the 6:00PM newscast.

In addition to local news, Molina has also covered national and international news stories; including her news series "En Directo desde Haiti" (*Direct from Haiti*), for which she received an Emmy® Award, and recognition from the Associated Press.

Molina began her broadcast career while still a university student. She worked as a fulltime reporter, focusing on investigative series and local politics.

She received her journalism degree from Florida International University and during her career has received multiple Emmy® Awards from the regional chapter of the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences.
